### What is MICROBIOMES4SOY?

MICROBIOMES4SOY is a 5-year research initiative (2024–2028) funded by Horizon Europe. The project focuses on the pivotal role microbiomes play in shaping both environmental and human health, with a particular emphasis on the soya bean crop.

Bringing together 17 partners from 10 countries—including leading universities, research centres, non-profit organisations, and private sector innovators—the project fosters collaboration to drive knowledge and innovation in the dynamic field of microbiome-based research.
